

 After the hospital have finished with you, you can go straight home. You should be home in time for your lunch!




How much do I drink?

 You can get drinks when you get to the hospital, the nurse can tell you how much you need to drink.



What Is the Test?

 The speed of your wee coming out of your bladder needs to be measured.



Don't Worry

 You won't need to get undressed for this procedure, you only need to show your tummy, maybe wear a blouse or t shirt?



What Happens Next?

 Some cold gel is spread on your tummy and a scanner is placed over you to look at your bladder.



How Long Will it Take?

• The test should take approximately 5 minutes, as long as the test works on the first try.



What do I do?

 You will need to wee on a machine so that the speed can be measured.



Then What?

 Next the nurse will ask you to lie on a trolley, so she can check if your bladder is empty.
